Needed: Children in the 8-12 age range who have a brother or sister diagnosed with **Asperger Syndrome** and who might be interested in participating in a videotape interview for following project.

Coulter video has been working the last six weeks on two new videos for siblings to help increase awareness of both autism and Asperger Syndrome. We have traveled around NC and down to the Atlanta area and have interviewed 15 families so far.

We will produce two videos-one for siblings of children and young adults who have a brother or sister with **Asperger's Syndrome** and another for siblings of children and young adults who have a brother or sister with **Autism spectrum conditions**. We are trying very hard to make sure we have a good balance of ages and racial background and including both genders in each video.

After reading Sandra Harris' book for siblings, we decided to create 4 segments in each video to reach the developmental level of the audience:

- segment for children from ages 5-8--will probably have puppets and narrator
- segment for children from ages 8-12--will included interviews with siblings and a narrator
- segment for teenagers and young adults--will included interviews with siblings and a narrator
- segment for parents--will included interviews with parents and a narrator
