### **Changes to IPRS Target Population Form November 18, 2005**

The Division of MH/DD/SAS has changed reporting requirements. Accordingly, WHN has updated the IPRS Target Population Worksheet with the following changes:

#### **Items removed from both the Adult and Child IPRS Target Population Worksheets:**

- All "AO" target population designations: ADAO, AMAO, ASAO, CDAO, CMAO, and CSAO. (These target populations will be assigned by ACCESS only.)
- The entry of all assessment scales and scores (GAF and CAFAS, etc.) are no longer necessary.
- All references to the CAFAS have been removed.
- PATH-(This target population will be assigned by WHN personnel only.)

#### **Items added to both the Adult and Child IPRS Target Population Worksheets:**

- Target Population Effective Date entry is required. Enter the date the target population(s) selection on the worksheet will begin.
- KTRNA-new target population used to track services for Hurricane Katrina Evacuees. This is a non-billable, tracking only, target population and must be used in conjunction with other existing target populations.
- The Provider Name and Provider Number assigning the Target Population data must be entered on each form.

#### **Additional Target Populations or Changes to existing Target Populations on the new IPRS Worksheets:**

- CSMAJ- for a child in the MAJORS SA/Juvenile Justice Program
- AMOLM-for adults identified as participants in the AMH Olmstead Plan Implementation (now assigned by WHN personnel only)

*These changes in reporting should be implemented as soon as possible for new admissions, but no later than January 1, 2006.*
