**DMA Lapse Dates for
Enhanced Benefit Services**

Upon review of the most recent report from DMA regarding lapse dates of conditional endorsement for Phase I and Phase II Enhanced Benefit Services, WHN has learned that lapse dates for services in Phase I and Phase II have been changed by DMA. Regardless of endorsement date, **all Phase I and Phase II services now have a DMA lapse date of 9/20/07. This means all providers of those services will need to receive full endorsement prior to 9/20/07 to avoid their having their service and site specific DMA numbers lapse.**

Services in these windows are as follows:

- All Community Support Services
- Diagnostic Assessment
- Mobile Crisis
- Intensive In-Home
- Multi-systemic Therapy (MST)
- Assertive Community Treatment Team
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation
- Substance Abuse Comprehensive Outpatient Treatment

Furthermore, DMA has issued a **lapse date of 11/30/07 for all services in Phase III.**

Those services are listed below:

- Substance Abuse Non-Medical Community Residential Treatment
- Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient
- Substance abuse Medically Monitored Community Residential Treatment
- Day Treatment
- Facility Based Crisis
- Opioid Treatment
